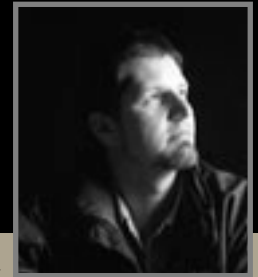

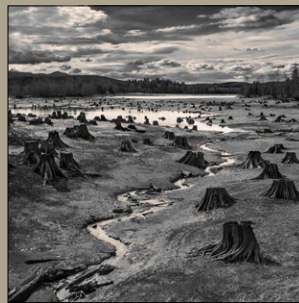

Awards, Exhibitions & Collections

Awards: On February 26th it was announced by the [Sony World Photography Organization](#) that my image had won the Open Competition in the Landscape category. Some 325,000 images were submitted to the competition.

Solo Exhibitions: An exhibition of my glacial silt series, *Flow*, is on tour in Alaska. This work was first featured in *LensWork's* first iteration of *Seeing in SIXES*. The show opened at the Fairbanks Arts Association's gallery



in Fairbanks, Alaska in February. The show next travels to my hometown, Anchorage, Alaska, at the Cyrano's ArtSpace Gallery in April 2019. The final scheduled exhibition will be at the Bunnell Street Arts Center in Homer, Alaska, August 2020. The exhibition consists of 23 framed prints 21x21 and 10x10.

Purchases and Collections: I had an image purchased by the Office of Arts & Culture's [Seattle Public Utilities](#) *Fresh Perspectives Portable Artwork* collection, Seattle, Washington.

Juried Exhibitions: In January 2019 I was accepted into the [Photographic Center Northwest's](#) 22nd annual juried exhibition.

I had four images selected for the Alaska Photographic Center's *Rarefied Light* traveling exhibition and received two honorable mentions from juror Arthur Meyerson.
