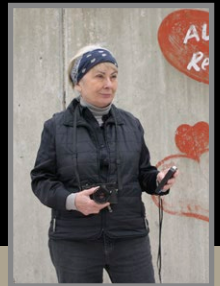

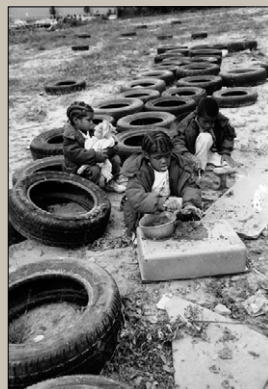
February – June 2018
