Artist talk, Book Signing & Exhibition

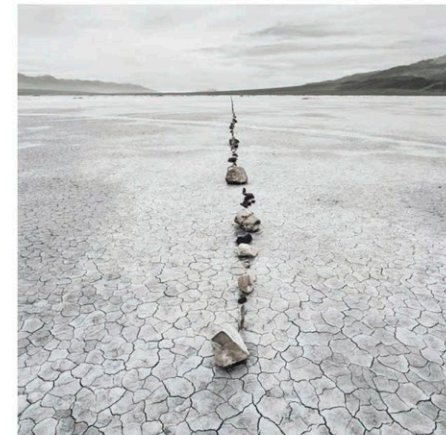
